

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 03, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 1 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 2, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** DATED DECEMBER 30 & 31, 1857 TO SURVEY THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-18-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE 1/4 POST ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SECTION 34 AND THE STONE HE FOUND BROKEN TO PIECES AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-18-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE MARKED THE FOLLOWING WITNESS AND LINE TREE:
 - 1) WHITE OAK 7' CIR. S. 78°05' W. AT 59 LINKS TO EAST SIDE OF TREE

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

 - 1) 19.97 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE FOUND BROKEN TO PIECES AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 34-18-11
 - 2) 19.97 CHAINS WEST TO THE FOUND STONE SOUTH 1/4 POST OF SECTION 34-18-11
 - 3) 40.01 CHAINS WEST TO A STONE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE W1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-18-11
 - 4) 60.05 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34-18-11

- 2) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 39 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 41 TO 43 DATED SEPTEMBER 21, 1859 TO MEASURE AND DESCRIBE THAT PART OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND THE WEST 1/2 OF THE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-18-11, BEING A LOT OF LAND SOLD BY A. B. ELLIOTT TO THOMAS ARMOR, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE SOUTH 1/4/4 STONE POST** OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 34-18-1 ON THIS SURVEY.

 - 1) 19.97 CHAINS WEST TO THE FOUND STONE SOUTH 1/4 POST OF SECTION 34-18-11
 - 2) 40.01 CHAINS WEST TO THE FOUND STONE S1/4/4 POST OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 34-18-11
