

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 105, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 105 DATED JUNE 2, 1885 FOR J. P. SIEVER, PRINCIPLE PETITIONER FOR A ROAD IN SECTION 4-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET AN ANGLE STONE** AT 1,320' EAST OF THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE FOR 1,320' TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 4 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
 - 2) THIS ROAD ANGLES TO THE SOUTHEAST TO INTERSECT THE EAST LINE OF SECTION 4 AT A ROAD STONE HE SET AT 1,290' NORTH OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 4
