

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 07, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 9 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 107 DATED JANUARY 1868 TO SURVEY THE FRACTIONAL SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE FOR THE PROPERTY DIVISION CORNER** BETWEEN THE WEST AND EAST HALVES OF THE SOUTHWEST FRACTIONAL 1/4 OF SECTION 7 ON LINE AND EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE ESTABLISHED CENTER OF SECTION 7 ON THIS SURVEY. THERE IS NO DRAWING AS HE NOTED THAT THE LAND OWNERS DID NOT WISH THEIR LANDS PLATTED.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 19.37-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7 ON THE RANGE LINE
 - 2) 19.37-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE ESTABLISHED CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7
 - 3) 59.37-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7
- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 26 OF THE 8TH TERM, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 81 DATED MAY 28, 1874 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND SUBDIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-11 INTO EAST AND WEST HALVES, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE "ALREADY SET"** AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 7 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,239-1/2' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE WEST BOUNDARY OF SECTION 7 ON THE RANGE LINE
- 2) 2,257-1/2' EAST TO THE 14" X 8" X 4" STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7
