

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROAD 297 IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 138 TO 140: ON JANUARY 6, 1885, A PETITION SIGNED BY H. PARKMAN AND OTHERS WAS PRESENTED TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR A 60 FOOT WIDE ROAD TO BE LOCATED WITHOUT VIEW AND SURVEY COMMENCING AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-11; THENCE EAST ON THE 1/2 SECTION LINE THROUGH SECTIONS 7, 8 AND THE WEST HALF OF THE WEST HALF OF SECTION 9 TO INTERSECT 12TH AVENUE AS INDICATED IN THE RECORDED PLAT OF COLLEGE HILL AND THE END OF THIS ROAD. ON APRIL 15, 1885, THE PETITION WAS APPROVED AS NOTED BY JOHN. L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JUNE 10, 1885 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK. THE TRUSTEE WAS NOTIFIED TO OPEN THE ROAD ON SEPTEMBER 16, 1885.
- 2) W. D. KRETSINGER, L.S. 363, COUNTY ENGINEER, BY LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 16 DATED MARCH 22, 1956 TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE LINE BETWEEN LOTS 83 AND 85 ON WOODLAND STREET IN WOODLAND PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF EMPORIA FOR HENRY SMITH AND PAUL MURPHY, SHOWS ON HIS DRAWING THAT **HE FOUND AN IRON PIN** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF 12TH AVENUE AND SUNNYSLOPE STREET ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE BOOKS.

GOULD, L.S. 142, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 25 DATED DECEMBER 2, 1957 FOR A. G. HARRISON AND E. M. ANDERSON TO PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN LOTS 86 AND 88 IN WOODLAND PARK ADDITION, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING AN **IRON PIN** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF 12TH AVENUE AND SUNNYSLOPE AVENUE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 31 DATED JUNE 19, 1958 FOR THE BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN LOTS 77 AND 79 ON WOODLAND AVENUE, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING AN **IRON PIN** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF 12TH AVENUE AND SUNNYSLOPE AVENUE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
