

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 09, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 29, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 29 DATED APRIL 25, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CORNERS OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A TEMPORARY 1/2/4 CORNER** ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE POST HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 9-19-11 AND THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-19-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,327' NORTH TO THE FOUND CENTER POST STONE OF SECTION 9-19-11
2) 1,327' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9-19-11
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 306 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 174 TO 176 PETITIONED BY D. L. INEDIKER AND OTHERS FOR A COUNTY ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 [PACKET 539 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON OCTOBER 14, 1885, WAS ESTABLISHED AS A **60 FOOT WIDE ROAD** ON OCTOBER 12, 1885 AS NOTED BY JOHN L. BUTLER, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND RECORDED ON JANUARY 28, 1886 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, DOES NOT MENTION THE 1/16TH CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) THE ROAD ALLOWED EAST ON THE 1/4 OF 1/4 SECTION LINE TO 9TH AVENUE AT THE WEST LINE OF LEWIS' ADDITION TO THE CITY OF EMPORIA TO END THE ROAD ALLOWED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
2) THE ROAD ALLOWED EXTENDS WEST ON THE 1/4 OF 1/4 SECTION LINE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/16TH CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11, THEN EXTENDS NORTH ON THE SECTION LINES FOR 1/4 OF A MILE TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11 TO BEGIN THE ROAD ALLOWED ON THIS ROAD SURVEY
- 3) W. D. KRETSINGER, L.S. 363, COUNTY ENGINEER, BY LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 7 SURVEYED OCTOBER 28, 1954, AT THE REQUEST OF RAY COBLE TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH THE NORTH 40 FEET OF LOT 57 AND THE SOUTH 20 FEET OF LOT 59, AND LYNN ORMSBY TO LOCATE AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISH ALL OF LOT 55 AND THE SOUTH 10 FEET OF LOT 57, ALL IN WOODLAND PARK ADDITION ON SUNNYSLOPE STREET IN THE CITY OF EMPORIA AND LOCATED IN THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING AN **IRON PIN** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF 9TH AVENUE AND THE WEST LINE OF LINCOLN STREET ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
- 4) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 44 DATED SEPTEMBER 9, 1963 TO LOCATE THE BOUNDARIES OF LOTS 5 & 7 IN THE SECOND WESTVIEW ADDITION, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING AN **IRON PIN IN THE PAVEMENT** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF 9TH AVENUE AND LINCOLN STREET ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
