

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 118 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 206 DATED MAY 22, 1869 TO SURVEY 5 ACRES OF LAND IN THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST AND EAST 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 9 ON THIS SURVEY. HE NOTED THAT THIS CORNER WAS THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 5 ACRE LOT.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
 - 1) 40 RODS WEST TO A STONE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE 5 ACRE LOT
 - 2) 20 RODS NORTH TO A STONE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE 5 ACRE LOT

- 2) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "A" ON PAGES 189 & 190 AND DATED MAY 1871, STATES THAT HE BEGAN THIS ROAD SURVEY AT A POINT THIRTY FEET SOUTH OF THIS CORNER.

- 3) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 153 DATED MAY 19, 1903 ORDERED BY HERMAN WHITE, ET. AL. FOR A SURVEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOCATING AND PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHING THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF THAT PORTION OF NORMAL ADDITION TO THE CITY OF EMPORIA LYING NORTH OF WALNUT STREET, AND ALSO THE CORNERS AND BOUNDARIES OF LOTS NUMBER 30 & 31 IN SAID ADDITION, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/2/4 OF SECTION 10-19-11 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN HIS BOOK NUMBER 3 ON PAGE 158, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS IN PACKET "M 128" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 7 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 1,324' NORTH TO AN IRON HE FOUND THAT WAS SUPPOSED TO BE THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10
 - 2) 1,324' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 10

- 4) W. D. KRETSINGER, L.S. 363, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1952 TO 1981, IN SURVEY SR # 9052 IN THE LARGE SURVEY DRAWER FOR SECTIONS 9 & 10 IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 BUT NOT DATED, SHOWS A **"MONUMENT"** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9.

- 5) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN SURVEY SR #9018 IN THE LARGE SURVEY DRAWER FOR SECTIONS 9 & 10 IN TOWNSHIP 19-11, DATED MAY 25, 1961, SHOWS A **"MONUMENT"** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9.
