

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 45, A PERMANENT SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 44 DATED MAY 3, 1870 TO RUN OUT THE LINES OF A 20 ACRE TRACT OF LAND LOCATED IN THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 2 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 660' EAST TO A POST SET FOR THE 1/4/4 CORNER AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 20 ACRE TRACT
- 2) 1,308' EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 2, 1, 12 & 11
- 3) 1,308' WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 2
- 4) 1,320' NORTH TO A STAKE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE 20 ACRE TRACT
- 5) 2,640' NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST & WEST LINE PASSING THROUGH THE CENTER OF SECTION 2
