

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 93 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 186, 187 & 188 DATED FEBRUARY 21, 1869 TO SURVEY THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-19-11 INTO 5 ARE LOTS, MORE OR LESS, LEAVING 40 FEET ON THE EAST AND 40 ON THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY, AND A STREET 80 FEET IN THE CENTER OF LOT RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH, AND ALSO A STREET 60 FEET IN WIDTH IN THE MIDDLE ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NORTH EAST LOT AS PER THE APPLICATION OF C. C. KNOTT, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-19-11 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 11-19-11 ON THIS SURVEY.
  
- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN A PLAT SHOWING THE RESULTS OF A **PERMANENT SURVEY** OF A TRACT OF LAND IN THE NORTHWEST OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-19-11 SURVEYED MAY 12, 1967 AND RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 2 ON PAGE 51, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING A "**MONUMENT**" AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 11-19-11 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTERLINE OF 12<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AND THE CENTERLINE OF WHITTIER STREET TO THE SOUTH ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.  
HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 349.355' SOUTH TO A MARK "CHISELED IN PAVING" AT THE INTERSECTION OF WHITTIER STREET AND 11<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE TO THE WEST
  - 2) 721.738' SOUTH TO A MARK "CHISELED IN PAVING" IN THE CENTERLINE OF WHITTIER STREET WITNESSED BY AN IRON PIN HE SET 25 FEET WEST ON THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF WHITTIER STREET
