BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED JUNE 24, 2003, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03220-02, SAID THAT HE DUG WITH A COUNTY MAINTAINER AND **HE FOUND A 4" X 12" LIMESTONE AT 27" DEEP AND FIRM IN THE GROUND, WITH THE TOP 8" OF THE STONE FRACTURED AT THIS TRACT CORNER. THIS STONE IS 994.04 FEET EAST OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12.**
  - 1) 26.86' NE TO A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS CAP SET
  - 2) 27.25' NW TO A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS CAP SET
  - 3) 25.60' SW TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
  - 4) 3.50' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF ROAD 180 TO THE EAST
  - 5) 12.50' WEST TO A LINE OF POWER POLES TO THE NORTH EXTENDED
  - 6) 41.00' NE TO THE TOP CENTER OF A TELEPHONE PEDESTAL
