

**TRACT CORNER 822.97 FEET WEST OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12,  
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) W. G. RUGGLES, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1915 TO 1928, IN A LEGAL SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 183 AND DATED MARCH 1926, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE GENTNER TRACT AT 12.45 CHAINS WEST OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12 ON THIS LEGAL SURVEY.**
  
- 2) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 03220-02, SAID THAT **HE FOUND A 6" X 8" X 14" LIMESTONE AT THIS CORNER FROM A PERMANENT SURVEY BY W. G. RUGGLES, COUNTY ENGINEER FROM 1915 TO 1928. HE PLACED A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP THROUGH THE CENTER OF THE FRACTURED STONE. THIS STONE IS 882.97 FEET WEST OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12.**
