

**TRACT CORNER 993.72 FEET WEST OF THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12,
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MARCH 10, 2009 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 09055-02 AND SURVEY F01008 IN THE TOWNSHIP FILE FOR SECTIONS 1-8 IN TOWNSHIP 19-11, SAID THAT HE EXCAVATED WITH A COUNTY MAINTAINER FOR THE STONE SET BY S. K. McCRARY IN 1905, AND **HE FOUND THE STONE FIRM IN THE GROUND WITH THE TOP BROKEN AT THIS TRACT CORNER. HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP ON THE SOUTH SIDE CENTER OF THE STONE AND A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS CAP ON THE NORTH SIDE CENTER OF THE STONE.**
 - 1) 20.0' NORTH TO A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS CAP SET
 - 2) 63.4' ESE TO A 40 D NAIL & WASHER IN A POWER POLE
 - 3) 3.0' SOUTH TO THE TRAVELED WAY FO THE GRAVEL ROAD EAST-WEST [EAST 18TH AVENUE]
 - 4) 993.72' EAST TO A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP [SOUTHEAST CORNER SECTION 01-19-11]
 - 5) 662.19' WEST TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS CAP
