

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) MATTHEW BROWN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1888 TO 1900, AND 1914, BY J. MAX YINGLING, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 128 DATED JUNE 12, 1911 TO ASCERTAIN THE CENTERLINE OF THE ROAD ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 12-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A 12" X 8" X 6" STONE** HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12 AND THE STONE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12 ON THIS ROAD SURVEY. HE DOES **NOT** CALL THIS STONE THE 1/16TH CORNER.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 844.5' NORTH TO A STONE HE FOUND IN PLACE
- 2) 1,323' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12
- 3) 1,323' SOUTH TO A 12" X 6" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12
- 4) 3,969' SOUTH TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 12 WHERE LINE COINCIDES WITH A STAKE SET FOR THIS CORNER
