WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 22 COMPLETED FEBRUARY 1, 1859, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-19-11 INTO 10 ACRE, 20 ACRE, AND 40 ACRE LOTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE CENTER POST OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STAKES HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4/4 POST AND THE SOUTH 1/4/4 POST OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 20.02 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4/4 POST OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
- 2) 10.01 CHAINS NORTH TO A STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
- 3) 20.02 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4/4 POST OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
