

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 22 COMPLETED FEBRUARY 1, 1859, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-19-11 INTO 10 ACRE, 20 ACRE, AND 40 ACRE LOTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE NORTH 1/4/4 CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE EAST 1/4 STONE POST AND THE STONE CENTER POST OF SECTION 15 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
- 1) 20.02 CHAINS EAST TO THE FOUND EAST 1/4 STONE POST OF SECTION 15
  - 2) 10.01 CHAINS WEST TO A STAKE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW 10 ACRE LOT
  - 3) 20.02 CHAINS WEST TO THE FOUND STONE CENTER POST OF SECTION 15 SET BY C. F. OAKFIELD IN THE SURVEY OF EMPORIA TOWNSITE AND CONSENTED TO BY THE PARTIES CONCERNED
  - 4) 10.01 CHAINS SOUTH TO A STAKE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
  - 5) 20.02 CHAINS SOUTH TO A STAKE SET FOR THE CENTER POST OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
  - 6) 40.04 CHAINS SOUTH TO A STAKE SET FOR THE S1/4/4 POST OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
