

**CNSE 1/64TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED FEBRUARY 26, 2002, FOR PROJECT 01004, SAID THAT SHE SET THIS CORNER AT 1/2 THE TOTAL DISTANCE AND ON LINE BETWEEN THE NORTHWEST AND SOUTHWEST CORNERS OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 16. SHE SAID THAT THE POINT IS ALSO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF WILSON'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF EMPORIA. **SHE SET A 1/2" REBAR WITH A CAP NEAR CONCRETE AROUND A FENCE CORNER FOR THIS CORNER.**
 - 1) 69.65' TO A CONCRETE NAIL & A BOTTLE CAP IN A 48" MULBERRY TREE
 - 2) 48.25' SE TO THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE FOUNDATION OF A CHURCH BUILDING
 - 3) 1.5' SW TO A CONCRETE NAIL & BOTTLE CAP IN A LIGHT POLE
 - 4) 14.7' WEST TO THE CENTER OF THE TRAVELED WAY
 - 5) 35.15' NE TO THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SIDEWALK AT THE SOUTH END
 - 6) 1.2' SOUTH TO AN IRON PIPE CORNER FENCE POST
 - 7) 0.4' WEST TO AN IRON PIPE CORNER FENCE POST
 - 8) 1.85' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR FOUND, PAINTED ORANGE, WITH NO CAP
