

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 32, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 32 DATED APRIL 27, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER OF SECTION 17-19-11, THE 1/2/4 CORNERS ON THE NORTH AND EAST SIDES OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 INTO 4 EQUAL PARTS, AND THE DIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO 4 EQUAL PARTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 17 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER AND THE CENTER OF SECTION 17 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17
- 2) 1,320' NORTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER OF SECTION 17
- 3) 2,640' NORTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 17
- 4) 3,960' NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17
