

**WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 167, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 167 DATED APRIL 25, 1887 ORDERED BY G. W. ANDERSON TO SURVEY AND LOCATE THE LINES AND CORNERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A TRIANGULAR LIMESTONE 3" X 12" AT THE BASE, 15" LONG, AND SHARP ON THE TOP** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER AND THE STONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY.**

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:**

- 1) 1,324' NORTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 18
- 2) 1,324' SOUTH TO THE 4" X 9" X 17" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 18
- 3) 3,874' SOUTH TO THE LOCATION FOR THE STUMPS OF LINE TREES RECORDED IN THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY HE FOUND TO DETERMINE THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19 – NO STONE FOUND
