

**CENTER CORNER SOUTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 167, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 167 DATED APRIL 25, 1887 ORDERED BY G. W. ANDERSON TO SURVEY AND LOCATE THE LINES AND CORNERS OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A 4" X 7" X 14" LIMESTONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 AND THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:**

- 1) 1,321-1/2' NORTH TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18
- 2) 1,321-1/2' SOUTH TO THE 2-1/2" X 12" X 14" LIMESTONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18
