

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 8 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 106 DATED JANUARY 1868, SAID THAT **HE ESTABLISHED A PROPERTY DIVISION CORNER** ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 18 ON LINE AND EQUIDISTANT FROM THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHED CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18 ON THIS SURVEY. THERE IS NO DRAWING AS HE NOTED THAT THE LAND OWNERS DID NOT WISH THEIR LANDS PLATTED.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
- 1) 19.19 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18
  - 2) 19.19 CHAINS EAST TO THE PERMANENTLY ESTABLISHED CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18
  - 3) 39.19 CHAINS EAST TO THE PROPERTY DIVISION CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18
  - 4) 59.19 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18
