

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 8 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 106 AND DATED JANUARY 1868, SAID THAT **HE ESTABLISHED A PROPERTY DIVISION CORNER** ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 18 ON LINE AND EQUIDISTANT FROM THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST AND SOUTH 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 18 ON THIS SURVEY. THERE IS NO DRAWING AS HE NOTED THAT THE LAND OWNERS DID NOT WISH THEIR LANDS PLATTED.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
 - 1) 19.00 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 18
 - 2) 19.00 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18

- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 162 AND DATED APRIL 1887, SAID THAT **HE SET A 2.5" X 12" X 14" LIMESTONE** FOR THIS 1/2/4 CORNER ON THIS SURVEY.
