

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 124 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **LEGAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 46 DATED NOVEMBER 19, 1873 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A TEMPORARY 1/2/4 CORNER** ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 16, 17, 20 & 21 AND THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 BETWEEN SECTIONS 16 & 21 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
- 1) 1,320' WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CORNER TO SEC. 16, 17, 20 & 21
 - 2) 1,320' EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 16 & 21
