- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 124 OF THE 7TH TERM, A **LEGAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "C" ON PAGE 46 DATED NOVEMBER 19, 1873 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER AND DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21-19-11, SAID THAT **HE SET A POST** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 21 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 20 & 21 AND THE 12" X 8" X 2" LIMESTONE THAT HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 21 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
