

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 22 COMPLETED FEBRUARY 1, 1859, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15-19-11 INTO 10 ACRE, 20 ACRE, AND 40 ACRE LOTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE SOUTH 1/4/4 POST OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 15 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 POST AND THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
- 1) 10.02-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO A STAKE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
 - 2) 20.05 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE SOUTH 1/4 POST OF SECTION 15
 - 3) 20.05 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 15
 - 4) 20.02 CHAINS NORTH TO A STAKE SET FOR THE CENTER POST OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
 - 5) 30.03 CHAINS NORTH TO A STAKE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NW1/4 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
 - 6) 40.04 CHAINS NORTH TO A STAKE SET FOR THE NORTH 1/4/4 POST OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 15
