

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 145, A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 144 DATED DECEMBER 1, 1871 FOR A ROAD PETITIONED BY W. T. SODEN FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19, RANGE 11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 22 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY.
- 2) IN A BROWN FILED BOOK LABELED "CHAINING AND ALIGNMENT SOUTH-COMMERCIAL AND NEOSHO RAPIDS HARD SURFACE ROAD SURVEY" IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE DATED JULY 1919 ON PAGE 2 IT SHOWS THAT THEY BEGAN THIS SURVEY AT THE **STONE** AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 22.
