

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 38, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 38 DATED JUNE 1, 1870 TO PART OFF 40 ACRES FROM THE EAST OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF SECTION 23-19-11 PARALLEL WITH THE WEST LINE OF THE SECTION AND 7.55 CHAINS DISTANCE FROM THE NORTH & SOUTH DIVISION LINE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 23 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONES HE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST AND NORTH 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 23 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**, BUT THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
 - 1) 498-1/3' EAST TO A STONE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE 40 ACRE TRACT
 - 2) 1,328-1/2' EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 23
 - 3) 1,328-1/2' WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SEC. 23
- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN LARGE SURVEY SR #23001 IN THE SURVEY DRAWER FOR SECTIONS 17-36 IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 DATED MAY 13-15, 1969, SHOWS A "**MONUMENT**" AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-19-11, BUT THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.
- 3) SURVEY F23001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR SECTIONS 17-36 IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 WITH NO NAME OR DATE FOR TWO TRACTS IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-19-11, SHOWS A "**MONUMENT**" AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 23-19-11, BUT THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.
