

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 30, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 30 DATED APRIL 27, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER [TEMPORARY] AND DIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 25-19-11 BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH & SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE FOR THE TEMPORARY 1/2/4 CORNER** ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 25 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE POST HE SET FOR THE TEMPORARY CENTER OF SECTION 25 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,320-3/4' WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 25
- 2) 1,320-3/4' EAST TO A POST SET FOR THE TEMPORARY CENTER OF SECTION 25

- 2) LESLIE M. GOULD, L.S. 142, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1953 TO 1978, IN SURVEY F25003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR SECTIONS 17-36 IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 SHOWING THE LINES OF A SURVEY OF A TRACT OF LAND CONSISTING OF A PART THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 AND ALL OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 25-19-11, BUT NOT DATED, IT SHOWS THAT HE SET A "**MONUMENT**" AT 1,320' EAST OF THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25 FOR THE PLACE OF BEGINNING FOR THIS SURVEY, BEING THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE EAST ONE-HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 25, BUT THERE IS NO DESCRIPTION OF THE MONUMENT AND THERE ARE NO TIES ON THE SURVEY OR IN THE SURVEY TIE FILES.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,320' WEST TO A MONUMENT AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25
- 2) 1,860' SOUTH TO A MONUMENT SET FOR A TRACT CORNER
- 3) 2,652' SOUTH TO A MONUMENT SET FOR THE 1/16TH CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 25
- 4) 1,320' EAST TO A TEMPORARY POINT SET [CENTER OF SECTION 25?]
- 5) 2,640' EAST TO A MONUMENT SET FOR THE NORTHEAST TRACT CORNER
