

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 585 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGES 209 THROUGH 212 PETITIONED BY JOHN I. PRICE AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 [PACKET 725 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 22, 1903, FOR A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD, 20 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE LINE SURVEYED. THAT HE RECORDED ON DECEMBER 14, 1903, SAID THAT HE BEGAN THIS ROAD SURVEY AT THE EAST END OF AN OSAGE HEDGE ON THE LINE BETWEEN THE NORTH 1/2 AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-19-11. HE DID **NOT** CALL OUT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS WEST ALONG SAID HEDGE FOR 1/2 MILE TO THE PUBLIC ROAD RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH THROUGH THE CENTER OF SAID SECTION 27-19-11 AND THERE ENDING.
- 2) **COMMISSIONER'S ROAD JOURNAL BOOK "B", PAGE 66**
ON NOVEMBER 10, 1950 A PETITION SIGNED BY MARVIN L. BALDWIN FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 WAS PRESENTED TO GEORGE K. JACKSON, COUNTY CLERK. THE ROAD WAS VIEWED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND R. W. BALL, COUNTY ENGINEER, ON NOVEMBER 24, 1950 AND THE FINAL ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ON DECEMBER 12, 1950 **VACATED** THE FOLLOWING ROAD:
 - 1) BEGINNING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 27-19-11, THENCE SOUTH 3/4 OF A MILE TO AN EAST AND WEST ROAD RUNNING THRU SECTIONS 26 & 27-19-11 AND ENDING THERE
