

**CENTER 1/4 CORNER SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A LAND SURVEY REFERENCE REPORT DATED MAY 10, 1990, FOR JOB NUMBER 90074, SAID THAT HE CONSIDERED THAT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 27 WAS **OBLITERATED**. **HE SET A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 27.**
  - 1) 70.0' WNW TO A NAIL & SHINER IN A POWER POLE
  - 2) 68.5' EAST TO THE TOP OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY MARKER
  - 3) 69.0' SE TO THE SOUTH END OF A 12" CORRUGATED METAL PIPE CULVERT IN AN ENTRANCE
  - 4) IN LINE WITH A HEDGE TO THE WEST
  - 5) 1.5' WEST TO THE CENTERLINE OF K-57 HIGHWAY

**HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:**

  - 1) N.01°25'37"W. 2,627.56' TO THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27
  - 2) S.01°25'35"E. 2,642.20' SOUTH TO THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27
  - 3) KDOT BEARINGS (STATE PLANE COORDINATES)
