

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, BY D. W. BOWMAN, DEPUTY, IN SURVEY NUMBER 50 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 147, 148 & 149 DATED MAY 14-16, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY LOGAN AND OTHERS, BEING SECTION 22-19-11, TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER CORNER, TO DIVIDE THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 EQUALLY BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH, TO DIVIDE THE NORTHWEST 1/4 EQUALLY BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH, AND TO ESTABLISH OTHER PROPERTY CORNERS AS DESCRIBED, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 22 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER AND THE STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22 ON THIS SURVEY.

**HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:**

- 1) 80 RODS, 2-1/2 LINKS WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22
- 2) 80 RODS, 2-1/2 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE SET FOR THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22
- 3) 240 RODS, 7-1/2 LINKS EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 22
- 4) 160 RODS, 4-1/2 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 22
- 5) 320 RODS, 9 LINKS NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 22
