

**WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 13, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 13 DATED FEBRUARY 24, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER OF SECTION 28-19-11 AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO 1/4/4 LOTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 28 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER AND THE STONE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,315' NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SEC. 28
- 2) 1,315' SOUTH TO THE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28
- 3) 3,945' SOUTH TO THE STONE FOUND DOWN AND RESET BY MUTUAL CONSENT AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 28
