

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 585 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "D" ON PAGES 209 THROUGH 212 PETITIONED BY JOHN I. PRICE AND OTHERS FOR A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-11 [PACKET 725 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON SEPTEMBER 22, 1903, FOR A 40 FOOT WIDE ROAD, 20 FEET EACH SIDE OF THE LINE SURVEYED. THAT HE RECORDED ON DECEMBER 14, 1903, SAID THAT HE ENDED THIS ROAD SURVEY AT THE PUBLIC ROAD EXTENDING NORTH AND SOUTH THROUGH THE CENTER OF SECTION 27-19-11 AT THE WEST END OF AN OSAGE HEDGE ON THE LINE BETWEEN THE NORTH 1/2 AND THE SOUTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 27-19-11. HE DID **NOT** CALL OUT THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THIS ROAD SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST ALONG SAID HEDGE FOR 1/2 MILE TO THE EAST END OF THE OSAGE HEDGE ON THE LINE BETWEEN THE N1/2 AND THE S1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 27-19-11 TO BEGIN THIS ROAD SURVEY
