

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 13, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 13 DATED FEBRUARY 24, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE CENTER OF SECTION 28-19-11 AND TO SUBDIVIDE THE NORTHEAST 1/4 INTO 1/4/4 LOTS, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
  
- 2) C. H. RICE, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN AN INFORMAL SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "D" ON PAGE 159 DATED JUNE 8, 1883 AT THE REQUEST OF TOM PRICE TO SURVEY TO ESTABLISH THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNERS ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH LINES OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 28-19-11, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 28 ON THIS INFORMAL SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
  - 1) 19.98 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 28
  - 2) 39.96 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 28
