- 1) ANSON B. HARVEY, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 87, A **PRIVATE AGREEMENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 167 DATED FEBRUARY 1, 1904 BY THE ORDER OF EVEN R. GRIFFITH, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1' X 8" X 4" STONE** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29 ON THIS **PRIVATE AGREEMENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 2 ON PAGE 20 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS.

HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 19.97 CHAINS EAST TO A STAKE HE SET FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29
- 2) 19.97 CHAINS SOUTH TO A STAKE HE SET FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29
