

**NORTH 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) ANSON B. HARVEY, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN SURVEY NUMBER 87, A **PRIVATE AGREEMENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 167 DATED FEBRUARY 1, 1904 BY THE ORDER OF EVEN R. GRIFFITH, SAID THAT **HE SET A STAKE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 29 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STAKE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER AND THE STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29 ON THIS **PRIVATE AGREEMENT SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 2 ON PAGE 20 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS. **HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:**
- 1) 19.97-1/2 CHAINS EAST TO A STAKE HE SET FOR THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29
  - 2) 19.97-1/2 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 29
  - 3) 19.97 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 1' X 8" X 4" STONE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 29
