PARKER TO MAKE A SURVEY OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 31-19-11 AND TO DIVIDE SAID NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 INTO TWO EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 31 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY WAS BEGUN ON MAY 8, 1907.
