

**WEST 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 11 EAST**

- 1) J. HARRISON PARKMAN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1907 TO 1915, IN SURVEY NUMBER 192, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN PERMANENT SURVEY BOOK 1 ON PAGE 12 REQUESTED BY R. J. PARKER TO MAKE A SURVEY OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 31-19-11 AND TO DIVIDE SAID NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 INTO TWO EQUAL PARTS BY A LINE RUNNING NORTH AND SOUTH, SAID THAT **HE SET A PERMANENT STAKE** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 31 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. THE SURVEY WAS BEGUN ON MAY 8, 1907.

HIS NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 1,292-75/100' WEST TO A PERMANENT STAKE HE SET FOR THE CENTER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 31
- 2) 2,585-5/10' WEST TO INTERSECT THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 31
- 3) 1,320' SOUTH TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 31
