

WEST 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST

- 1) ALVA J. SMITH, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1900 THROUGH 1906, IN SURVEY NUMBER 69, A **LEGAL SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "F" ON PAGE 148 DATED MARCH 17 & 18, 1903 AT THE REQUEST OF ROBERT H. EVANS, SAID THAT **HE SET A SANDSTONE ON LINE WITH A FENCE AND 30 FEET EAST OF A HEDGE** FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE RESTORED FROM THE SLEEPER SURVEY FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34 ON THIS **LEGAL SURVEY**. HIS FIELD NOTES ARE IN BOOK 3 ON PAGE 122 IN THE "KRETSINGER COLLECTION" OF FIELD BOOKS AND THERE IS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN PACKET "M 71" IN MISCELLANEOUS DRAWER NUMBER 3 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
HIS DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
- 1) 20.09 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE RESTORED FROM THE SLEEPER SURVEY FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34
 - 2) 60.73 CHAINS NORTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34
 - 3) 20.09 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 34
 - 4) 59.79 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 3-20-11
