

**CENTER OF SECTION 01, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 7, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 7 DATED FEBRUARY 25-29, 1884 BY THE ORDER OF A. E. SLOUGHTON TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 1-19-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 1 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:
- 1) 20.08 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 1
  - 2) 40.16 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE WEST SIDE OF SECTION 1
  - 3) 20.08 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT 1/8<sup>TH</sup> CORNER ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 1
  - 4) 40.16 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE 1/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF SECTION 1 ON THE RANGE LINE
