

WEST 1/4 CORNER SECTION 04, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ON PAGE 534 OF THE GLO ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES IN THE DRAFTING ROOM IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE IT STATES THAT **THEY SET A LIMESTONE 22" X 11" X 3"** FOR THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 4 & 5-19-12 ON MARCH 4, 1857.
THE GOVERNMENT SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 38.42 CHAINS NORTH TO THE 22" X 10" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 4 & 5-19-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
 - 2) 40.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE 28" X 11" X 3" LIMESTONE THEY SET FOR THE CORNER TO SECTIONS 4, 5, 8 & 9-19-12

- 2) MATTHEW BROWN, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, FOR R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN SURVEY NUMBER 71, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 71 DATED OCTOBER 9 THROUGH NOVEMBER 1, 1884 ORDERED BY N. J. WIRT TO SURVEY THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 4-19-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A TEMPORARY STAKE** FOR THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4-19-12 AFTER RUNNING THE SECTION LINES FROM THE GOVERNMENT STONE THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 8-19-12 NORTH TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-19-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
 - 1) 2,538' NORTH TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-19-12 ON THE TOWNSHIP LINE
 - 2) 2,640' SOUTH TO THE TEMPORARY STAKE HE SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 4-19-12
 - 3) 7,920' SOUTH TO THE GOVERNMENT STONE HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 8-19-12
