

CENTER CORNER SECTION 06, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 37, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 37 DATED MAY 31, 1870 TO ESTABLISH THE 1/4 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 6 & 7-19-12, SHOWS ON HIS SURVEY DRAWING A **STONE** AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 6, BUT HE MAKES NO MENTION OF IT IN HIS SURVEY NOTES.

- 2) POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED JANUARY 20, 1997, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 96282-02, SURVEY F06002 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR A SUBDIVISION OF THE FRACTIONAL NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 6-19-12, SAID THAT **SHE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 6 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE QUARTER CORNERS. THIS CORNER IS ALSO THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE 90.08 ACRE JACOB TRACT.
 - 1) 18.10' NNW TO THE NORTH FACE OF A 26" DIAMETER HACKBERRY TREE
 - 2) 30.70' NW TO THE SOUTH FACE OF A 14" DIAMETER TWIN HACKBERRY TREE
 - 3) 7.30' WEST TO THE EAST FACE OF AN 8" DIAMETER ASH TREE
 - 4) 26.20' NE TO THE EAST SIDE OF AN 8" SILVER MAPLE TREE
 - 5) 23.90' EAST TO A TWIN SILVER MAPLE TREE

 - 1) 1,521.27' WEST TO A #5 REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE 90.08 ACRE JACOB TRACT
 - 2) 2,495.24' WEST TO A #4 REBAR FOUND AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6 AND THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE 59.50 ACRE THOMAS TRACT
 - 3) 2,589.50' NORTH TO AN IRON REBAR FOUND OVER THE EXISTING STONE PER RECORD AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6
 - 4) 2,623.80' EAST TO THE STONE FOUND AND MONUMENTED WITH AN IRON REBAR AND HER "LS 1130" CAP AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6
 - 5) 2,639.90' SOUTH TO MILLIKEN'S STONE FOUND AND MONUMENTED WITH AN IRON REBAR AND A LYON COUNTY CAP AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 6

- 3) POLLY A. JONES, L.S. 1130, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MAY 13, 1997, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 96283-02, SURVEY F06001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR A 12.97 ACRE TRACT AROUND AN EXISTING HOMESTEAD IN THE FRACTIONAL NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 6-19-12 FOR MRS. THOMAS, SAID THAT **SHE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 6 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE QUARTER CORNERS.
 - 1) 18.10' NNW TO THE NORTH FACE OF A 26" DIAMETER HACKBERRY TREE
 - 6) 30.70' NW TO THE SOUTH FACE OF A 14" DIAMETER TWIN HACKBERRY TREE
 - 7) 7.30' WEST TO THE EAST FACE OF AN 8" DIAMETER ASH TREE
 - 8) 26.20' NE TO THE EAST SIDE OF AN 8" SILVER MAPLE TREE
 - 9) 23.90' EAST TO A TWIN SILVER MAPLE TREE

HER SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

 - 1) 2,495.24' WEST TO A #4 REBAR FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 6
 - 6) 2,621.82' NORTH TO AN IRON REBAR FOUND OVER THE EXISTING STONE PER RECORD AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF SECTION 6
