WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 12 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 8 & 9 DATED JUNE 17, 1858, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** FOR DANIEL RICH AND DAVID MEDER TO ESTABLISH THE EAST & WEST 1/4/4 POSTS, THE EAST & WEST CENTER LINE, AND THE CENTER POST OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE POST** FOR THE WEST 1/4/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-9-12 ON LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE FOUND NORTH 1/4 STONE POST OF SECTION 7-18-12 AND THE STONE POST HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 1) 19.93 CHAINS NORTH TO THE FOUND NORTH 1/4 STONE POST OF SEC. 7-19-12
- 2) 19.93 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE POST HE FOUND AT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 7-19-12
- 3) 19.83 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE POST HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12
- 4) 39.66 CHAINS EAST TO THE STONE POST HE SET FOR THE E1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12
