

**WEST 1/16<sup>TH</sup> CORNER NORTHWEST QUARTER SECTION 08, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,  
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) G. M. WALKER, BRECKENRIDGE COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1857 TO 1860, IN SURVEY NUMBER 12 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGES 8 & 9 DATED JUNE 17, 1858, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** FOR DANIEL RICH AND DAVID MEDER TO ESTABLISH THE EAST & WEST 1/4/4 POSTS, THE EAST & WEST CENTER LINE, AND THE CENTER POST OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE POST** FOR THE EAST 1/4/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12 AT 20.00 CHAINS NORTH OF THE STONE POST THAT HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**. HE NOTED THAT THIS LOCATION WAS ESTABLISHED BY THE MUTUAL CONSENT OF DANIEL RICH AND DAVID MEDER. HE MARKED THE FOLLOWING WITNESS TREES:
  - 1) A HICKORY TREE 10" IN DIAMETER IS S. 4-1/4° W. AT 37 LINKS
  - 2) A BUR OAK TREE 10" IN DIAMETER IS S. 47-1/2° W. AT 53-1/2 LINKS
  - 3) A HICKORY TREE 12" IN DIAMETER IS N. 34° E. AT 58 LINKSHIS SURVEY NOTES SHOW THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) 20.00 CHAINS SOUTH TO THE STONE POST HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12
  - 2) 19.83 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT CENTER CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12
  - 3) 39.67 CHAINS WEST TO THE STONE POST HE SET FOR THE PERMANENT W1/4/4 CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 7-19-12
  
- 2) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "E" ON PAGE 155 DATED DECEMBER 2, 1886 FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR D. M. MAY, PRINCIPAL PETITIONER, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-19-12 AT A TURN IN THIS ROAD SURVEY.  
HIS SURVEY NOTES/DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:
  - 1) THIS ROAD EXTENDS EAST TO THE NEW ROAD STONE HE SET AT THE NORTH END OF A ROAD SURVEYED SEPTEMBER 15, 1886
  - 2) THIS ROAD EXTENDS SOUTH ON THE SECTION LINE TO THE ROAD STONE HE SET NORTH OF THE NEOSHO RIVER
  
- 3) R. H. EDMISTON, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1884 TO 1887, IN A ROAD SURVEY FOR ROAD NUMBER 345 RECORDED IN ROAD RECORD BOOK "C" ON PAGES 330 TO 332 PETITIONED BY D. M. MAY FOR THE **VACATION** OF A ROAD IN SECTION 8-19-12 [PACKET 600 IN THE VAULT IN THE COUNTY SURVEYOR'S OFFICE] THAT HE SURVEYED ON DECEMBER 2, 1886, WAS **VACATED IN PART** ON JANUARY 8, 1887 AS NOTED BY T. E. McMILLAN, CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AND WAS RECORDED ON MARCH 12, 1887 BY ROLAND LAKIN, COUNTY CLERK, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8-19-12 ON THIS ROAD **VACATION** SURVEY. SEE THE SURVEY NOTES FOR THE LOCATION OF THE ROAD THAT WAS APPROVED TO BE **VACATED**.
