

CENTER OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MARCH 2, 1992, **FOUND A 1/2" SQUARE REBAR LOOSE IN THE GROUND** AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 10 FROM THE CONSTRUCTION PLANS FOR I-35. **I REPLACED IT WITH A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP.**
 - 1) 64.8' NORTH TO A FOUND SPIKE & WASHER TIED TO A STEEL FENCE POST
 - 2) 73.0' NNE TO A FOUND SPIKE & WASHER TIED TO A STEEL FENCE POST
 - 3) 93.9' SOUTH TO A CONCRETE NAIL & 2 WASHERS IN THE TOP OF A CORNER FENCE POST FOR FENCES EAST-WEST-SOUTH
 - 4) 16.9' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF OLD HIGHWAY 50
 - 5) 81.3' NW TO A FOUND SPIKE & WASHER TIED TO A STEEL FENCE POST

- 2) WARREN CHIP WOODS, L.S. 603, COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED SEPTEMBER 05, 2001, FOR LYON COUNTY BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT NUMBER 01-66, **FOUND THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP AT 5" BELOW THE GROUND LEVEL ON THE NORTH EDGE OF ROAD 175 [OLD HIGHWAY 50]** AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 10 FROM THE PLANS FOR I-35 AND EXISTING TIES OF RECORD IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
 - 1) 64.8' NORTH TO A FOUND SPIKE & WASHER WIRED TO A STEEL FENCE POST
 - 2) 73.0' NNE TO A FOUND SPIKE & WASHER WIRED TO A STEEL FENCE POST
 - 3) 81.3' NW TO A FOUND SPIKE & WASHER WIRED TO A STEEL FENCE POST
 - 4) A FENCE BEARS SOUTH ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF ROAD 175
 - 5) 17' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF ROAD 175 [OLD HIGHWAY 50]

- 3) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED MARCH 8, 2005, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 04490-02, SURVEY F10001 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 FOR THE SURVEY OF TWO TRACTS IN THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 10-19-12, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 10 FROM EXISTING TIES OF RECORD IN THE COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE.
 - 1) 17.5' SOUTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF OLD 50 HIGHWAY [COUNTY ROAD 175]
 - 2) 91.0' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET
 - 3) 81.3' NW TO A SPIKE & WASHER WIRED TO A STEEL FENCE POST
 - 4) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE SOUTH

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

 - 1) 2,633.13' EAST TO A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 10
 - 2) 91.0' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE 7.82 ACRE TRACT AT "1667 ROAD 175" ON THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF OLD U.S. HIGHWAY 50/COUNTY ROAD 175
 - 3) 252.38' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE 7.82 ACRE TRACT AT "1667 ROAD 175" AT THE NORTHERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF I-35 HIGHWAY
 - 4) 2,641.00' SOUTH TO A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 10
