

**CENTER CORNER OF NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED JUNE 27, 2011 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 11159-02, A SURVEY OF THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 12-19-12 FOR BILL VEATCH, SURVEY F12005 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE CENTER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/16TH CORNERS ON THIS SURVEY.
 - 1) 0.5' NORTH TO A FENCE TO THE WEST
 - 2) 1.2' EAST TO A FENCE NORTH AND SOUTH
 - 3) 5.4' WEST TO A SPIKE & BOTTLECAP IN THE SOUTH FACE OF A BRACE POST
 - 4) 11.5' SOUTH TO A SPIKE & BOTTLECAP IN THE WEST FACE OF A GATE POST

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

 - 1) 668.25' WEST TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
 - 2) 1,336.50' WEST TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
 - 3) 1,328.21' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
 - 4) 1,336.50' EAST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE 1/16TH CORNER ON THE EAST LINE OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
 - 5) 1,328.21' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
