

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER NORTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED JUNE 27, 2011 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 11159-02, A SURVEY OF THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 12-19-12 FOR BILL VEATCH, SURVEY F12005 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12, SAID THAT HE DETERMINED A **THEORETICAL POSITION** FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 12 ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12 AND THE 80 D SPIKE [OVER THE STONE] FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 12, BUT HE DID **NOT** MONUMENT THIS CORNER ON THIS SURVEY.

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

- 1) 1,339.38' WEST TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
- 2) 1,339.38' EAST TO AN 80 D SPIKE [OVER THE STONE] FOUND AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
- 3) 1,328.21' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
- 4) 2,656.42' SOUTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
