- 1) STEVEN S. BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED JUNE 27, 2011 FOR PROJECT NUMBER 11159-02, A SURVEY OF THE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 12-19-12 FOR BILL VEATCH, SURVEY F12005 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 12 ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE 1/2" SQUARE REBAR FOUND AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 12 AND THE 1/2" REBAR WITH "LS 82" CAP FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12.
 - 1) 50.35' ESE TO THE NORTHWEST HUBGUARD OF A REINFORCED CONCRETE BOX CULVERT
 - 2) 29.5' NORTH TO THE CENTERLINE TRAVELED WAY OF OLD HIGHWAY 50
 - 3) IN LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE NORTH EXTENDED
 - 4) 105.85' NORTH TO THE TOP CENTER OF A 2" PIPE CORNER FENCE POST

HIS SURVEY DRAWING SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCES:

 - 1) 666.81' WEST TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE SW1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12 AS WITNESSED BY A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP SET 96.43' NORTH ON THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF OLD HIGHWAY 50 [ROAD 175]
 - 2) 1,333.62' WEST TO A 1/2" SQUARE REBAR FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
 - 3) 1,333.63' EAST TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH "LS 82" CAP FOUND AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
 - 4) 1,328.21' NORTH TO A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" SET FOR THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
 - 5) 2,656.42' NORTH TO THE THEORETICAL POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE NE1/4 OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 12
