

CENTER CORNER SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 21 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 117 DATED FEBRUARY 28 & 29, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF A. HENSHAW'S AND M. WEAVER'S LAND, BEING A DIVISION OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 AND 20 ACRES ON THE SOUTH END OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 17-19-12, SAID THAT HE RAN THE LINES CONNECTING THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS. HE SET A TEMPORARY POST 160 RODS EAST OF THE WEST 1/4 CORNER AND A TEMPORARY POST AT 160 RODS NORTH OF THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER. HE PROCEEDED TO CONNECT THE TEMPORARY POSTS, PROJECTED ANGLES AND BROUGHT THEM TOGETHER TO **ESTABLISH** THE CENTER OF SECTION 17. HE DID NOT SAY WHAT HE SET FOR THE CENTER OF SECTION 17.
