

**CENTER CORNER SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 67 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 167 DATED AUGUST 24, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY J. W. LANCE AND OTHER LYING IN SECTION 18019012, TO SURVEY THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE 1/4 CORNERS ON THIS SURVEY.

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED NOVEMBER 24, 2004, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 04408-02, SURVEY F18003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 TO MARK THE NORTH AND WEST LINES OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 18-19-12 LYING NORTH OF THE RAILROAD, SAID THAT HE CONSIDERED THAT THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-12 WAS **LOST**. **HE SET A 5/8" X 24" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP** FOR THE CENTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-12 AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE LINES FROM THE OPPOSITE QUARTER CORNERS.
  - 1) 2.5' NORTH TO THE CENTER OF CONCRETE
  - 2) 2,507.53' WEST TO THE WEST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-12
  - 3) 2,643.52' EAST TO THE EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-12
  - 4) 2,648.77' NORTH TO THE NORTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-12
  - 5) 2,648.64' SOUTH TO THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 18-19-12

  - 4) 2,643.52' EAST TO THE 1" X 6" BOLT HE SET FOR THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE E1/2 OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18-19-12
  - 5) 2,648.64' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18-19-12

  - 2) 2,618.96' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" X 24" IRON PIN WITH HIS "S. BROSEMER" CAP HE SET ON THE NORTH RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF COUNTY ROAD 160
  - 3) 2,648.96' SOUTH TO THE 1/2" IRON PIN HE FOUND AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE SE1/4 OF SECTION 18-19-12
