

**NORTH 1/16TH CORNER SOUTHEAST QUARTER SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,
RANGE 12 EAST**

- 1) D. T. McAULEY, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1867 TO 1870, IN SURVEY NUMBER 67 RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "A" ON PAGE 167 DATED AUGUST 24, 1868 FOR A SURVEY OF LAND OWNED BY J. W. LANCE AND OTHER LYING IN SECTION 18019012, TO SURVEY THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4, SAID THAT **HE SET A STONE** FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE WEST 1/2 OF THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18 EQUIDISTANT BETWEEN THE STONE HE SET FOR THE CENTER CORNER AND THE STONE HE FOUND AT THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 18 ON THIS SURVEY.

BROSEMER, L.S. 752, DEPUTY COUNTY SURVEYOR, IN A SECTION CORNER REPORT DATED NOVEMBER 24, 2004, FOR PROJECT NUMBER 04408-02, SURVEY F18003 IN THE SURVEY FILE FOR TOWNSHIP 19-12 TO MARK THE NORTH AND WEST LINES OF THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 18-19-12 LYING NORTH OF THE RAILROAD, SAID THAT **HE SET A 1/2" X 24" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP** FOR THE NORTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 18 ON TRUE LINE AND HALFWAY BETWEEN THE CENTER CORNER AND THE EAST QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 18.
 - 1) 1,321.76' EAST TO THE EAST QUARTER CORNER [A 1" BOLT]
 - 2) 1,321.76' WEST TO THE CENTER CORNER [A 5/8" REBAR WITH A LYON COUNTY CAP]
 - 3) 2,651/28' SOUTH TO THE SOUTH 1/16TH CORNER OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER [A 1/2" REBAR WITH HIS "LS 752" CAP]
 - 4) THIS CORNER FALLS IN CULTIVATION
