

CENTER CORNER SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST

- 1) ROBERT MILLIKEN, COUNTY SURVEYOR FROM 1870 TO 1875 AND FROM 1882 TO 1883, IN SURVEY NUMBER 22, A **PERMANENT SURVEY** RECORDED IN SURVEY BOOK "B" ON PAGE 22 DATED MARCH 23, 1870 TO FIND THE CENTER OF THE SOUTHWEST FRACTIONAL 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19-19-12 AND ESTABLISH THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19, SAID THAT **HE FOUND THE STONE** AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 19 ON THIS **PERMANENT SURVEY**.

HIS SURVEY NOTES SHOWS THE FOLLOWING DISTANCE:

- 1) 1,318.75' SOUTH TO A TEMPORARY STAKE SET FOR THE 1/2/4 CORNER ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE SW1/4 OF SECTION 19
- 2) 2,637.5' SOUTH TO THE STONE FOUND AT THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SEC. 19
